1. The World Bank has financed a US\$15 million funding assistance credit to the Government of Cambodia for Mekong Integrated Water Resources Management Phase 3 (M-IWRMP-3), credit number 5777-KH. This project is the regional World Bank financed Mekong Integrated Water Resources Management Program, which includes Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, Vietnam, and the Mekong River Commission (MRC). The objective of the Project is to enhance Cambodia's institutional capacity and infrastructure to sustainably manage its water and fishery resources in the northeast of Cambodia, and thus more effectively engage in trans-boundary water management. The project will be implemented in the Mekong river basin at the Northeast of Cambodia and the implementation duration of the Project is 5 years (2016-2020).

There are two components under this project of which Component 1 is managed by Fisheries Administration (FiA) as Implementing Agency for supporting the Fisheries and Aquatic Resources Management in Northern Cambodia and requires one Provincial Project Engineer Consultant for Kratie to assist and advise on all infrastructure-related activities of the project.

The Consultant will be expected to carry out the assignment with detail tasks included in Terms of Reference (ToR) on full time basis over a 3-year period. The workplace of the Consultant will be based in Provincial Implementation Team (PIT) Office, Fisheries Administration Cantonment, Kratie provincial town.

2. **Minimum qualifications to be quantitatively evaluated (scored)**

The interested consultant will be evaluated based on the qualification and relevant experience in regard to the minimum criteria listed below:

- Bachelor degree in civil engineering or related discipline.
- At least 3 years' work experience in designing and implementing infrastructure projects, preparing Bill of Quantities (BoQs), and monitoring and certifying works, preferably with the participation of multiple stakeholders at both national and local levels.
- Experience in working with local communities to design and deliver small-scale infrastructure projects.
- Knowledge and practice of World Bank safeguard policies and instruments would be an advantage including Environmental and Social Management Frameworks (ESMF); Ethnic Groups Planning Frameworks (EGPF); Compensation and Resettlement Policy Frameworks (CRPF); Environmental Codes of Practice (ECOPs) etc.
- Proficiency in English both written and speaking is required.

3. The selection process will be undertaken in accordance with the World Bank's Guidelines "Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers January 2011 and revised July 2014.

The FiA now invites applications for this assignment from eligible, qualified, and experienced individual national consultants to undertake the above mentioned services which are further detail in the Terms of Reference (ToR) for the assignment.
