1. The World Bank has financed a US\$15 million funding assistance credit to the Government of Cambodia for Mekong Integrated Water Resources Management Phase 3 (M-IWRMP-3), credit number 5777-KH. This project is the regional World Bank financed Mekong Integrated Water Resources Management Program, which includes Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, Vietnam, and the Mekong River Commission (MRC). The objective of the Project is to enhance Cambodia's institutional capacity and infrastructure to sustainably manage its water and fishery resources in the northeast of Cambodia, and thus more effectively engage in trans-boundary water management. The project will be implemented in the Mekong river basin at the Northeast of Cambodia and the implementation duration of the Project is 5 years (2016-2020).

There are two components under this project of which Component 1 is managed by Fisheries Administration (FiA) as Implementing Agency for supporting the Fisheries and Aquatic Resources Management in Northern Cambodia and requires one Kratie National Fisheries Resources Specialist to provide advice and support for the establishment, implementation and evaluation of community fisheries (CFi), fish conservation zones and the component implementation management, monitoring and reporting in the project area.

The Consultant will be expected to carry out the assignment with detail tasks included in Terms of Reference (ToR) on full time basis for a 3-year period, with possibility for extension of services. The workplace of the Consultant will be based in Kratie Province at the Office of Provincial Fisheries Administration (PFiA).

2. **Minimum qualifications to be quantitatively evaluated (scored)**

The interested consultant will be evaluated based on the qualification and relevant experience in regard to the minimum criteria listed below:

- Bachelor in fisheries or natural resources management is required.
- At least 5 years of experience of fisheries management is required, including some experience in the Mekong Region. Knowledge on indigenous people and gender issues is an advantage
- Fluency in English and Khmer language.

3. The selection process will be undertaken in accordance with the World Bank's Guidelines "Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers January 2011 and revised July 2014.

The FiA now invites applications for this assignment from eligible, qualified, and experienced individual national consultants to undertake the above mentioned services which are further detail in the Terms of Reference (ToR) for the assignment. The ToR can be requested through email to address indicated in paragraph 5 below and response can be done during office hours from 7:30AM to 12:00 noon and from 14:00PM to 17:30PM, Monday through Friday, except government public holidays.
